Artpace San Antonio is accepting applications for two paid summer internships to graduate students studying in fields related to art history, museum studies, or art education.

Artpace San Antonio serves as a laboratory for the creation and advancement of international contemporary art. Artpace believes that art is a dynamic social force that inspires individuals and defines cultures. Our residencies, exhibitions, and education programs nurture the creative expression of emerging and established artists, while actively engaging youth and adult audiences.

Through our International Artist-in-Residence program (IAIR), we invite nine artists annually to participate in a two-month residency. Each residency is comprised of three artists—one international, one living in the United States, and one from Texas. Artpace welcomes for the 10.2 residency Jamal Cyrus (Houston), Corey McCorkle (New York City), and Monika Sosnowska (Warsaw). In addition to IAIR, Artpace organizes three exhibitions per year in the Hudson (Show)Room.

The two graduate interns will work with the Curatorial, Education, and Public Programs Departments to: write Magazine articles and gallery notes; organize evening Public Programs; research for upcoming residencies; conduct educational tours; and partake in day-to-day office duties. Interns are encouraged to attend San Antonio art events and to become familiar with the contemporary art community in Texas.

Successful candidates shall work independently and collaboratively. They will apply their creativity, critical thinking skills, and enthusiasm to a wide range of projects under the mentorship of Artpace professionals. Artpace seeks applicants who devote significant energy to tasks at hand and bring to the table new ideas and creative solutions. A strong knowledge of contemporary art and exceptional verbal and written skills are required. Proficiency in reading and speaking Spanish is desirable. A \$2,500 stipend is given to each Intern for the two month, full-time position (June/July 2010).
